- No Refunds will be issued after Saturday 11 April 2026.
- Applicants will be advised of their site location via email by 12 April 2026.
- Fees are shown below. Unless otherwise negotiated, allocated space will be 4m wide by 3m deep.

## Terms and Conditions

### General

- All applications are subject to the acceptance of all terms and conditions contained within this expression of interest documentation (pages 1 through 4) and will become legally binding upon acceptance by the organising committee.
- The organising committee reserves the right to cancel the event either in part or its entirety if deemed unsafe due to circumstances or by advice/order from relevant health authorities. Where the event is cancelled in part which requires the withdrawal of stallholders, affected applicants will be issued a refund. Where the event is cancelled in full due to Government Department or health advice, refunds will be issued.
- Under no circumstances does the organising committee accept any liability for any reduction or loss of sales due to attendance numbers or cancellation in part or full.
- Stall holders are requested not to smoke in or near their stalls.
- No dogs allowed in stalls (unless it is an Assistance Dog and is qualified, accredited, and serving the person they are with). Documentation may be requested.
- Advertising balloons, blimps or other large inflatable devices are prohibited, unless prior written permission is received from the organising committee.
- Drones are not permitted unless approved by the organising committee, SES and subject to CASA legislation.
- Itinerant selling is prohibited. Traders' activities must be contained within the confines of the trader's allocated space.
- Traders are prohibited from offering any goods or services for sale other than those indicated on this application form, confirmation form and/or approved by the organising committee.
- Stalls/Trade Spaces **MUST** be set up by 8:30am - the event runs from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm. NO vehicles will be allowed into the event area after 8:30 am or prior to 4:00 pm.
- All cars are to be removed from the event area by 8:30 am unless **prior approval** is granted by the organising committee.
- Stall sizes are 4 m wide by 3 m deep. Multiple sites may be booked. Please consider your site requirements carefully as changes cannot be accepted on the day. Any request for additional space will be subject to availability.
- All Stall Holders must supply their own shelter and tables (if required).
- All temporary structures (e.g. Gazebos) **MUST** be adequately secured on all legs with weights. No pegs are to be used. Failure to use weights to secure temporary structures may result in removal from the event.
- All mobile stalls such as trolleys or trailers must have wheels secured with chocks.
- All traders shall have a current Public Liability Policy. You must submit a copy of your current Public Liability Insurance Policy or Certificate of Currency with your payment.

### Power

- Any extension cords used must carry a valid test tag.
- Multi way outlets (power boards) must include a safety circuit breaker.
- Cords must be covered by appropriate matting for the full length of the cord (no tape) as per Shire of Manjimup regulations.
- The use of double adaptors is prohibited.

**Food Stalls**

- The event committee encourages healthy choices for food and beverages.
- Any use of food packaging, serving trays, bowls, cups and utensils must comply with current regulations.
- All equipment and cooking requirements must meet Shire of Manjimup health regulations.
- Food Stall applicants must submit a copy of their Food Act 2008 Food Handling Registration as issued by their Local Government Authority with this application.

**Prohibited Items**

- The sale, distribution or use is prohibited of any item which may, by its use or operation, cause alarm or distress to any person or any animal.
- Balloons (gas filled), unless the balloon is fitted to a non-conductive and rigid rod or straw.
- Knives (excluding eating utensils), bow and arrows of any description, guns, cap guns and/or cartridges for cap guns, potato guns, water pistols or any such items used to launch projectiles.
- Celluloid toys, unless they comply with Health Department Regulations and a permit has been obtained. Permits must be available for inspection.
- Chemical sprays, silly string, stage door streamers or other similar projected items including shaving cream, shaving foam and other similar items.
- Fireworks, including sparklers of any description.
- Kites, unless they are disassembled and packaged.
- Laser light pointers and all forms of light pertaining to lasers.
